At Liferay, we believe an accessible product is a better product, which is why we've made accessibility a strategic priority..

We are committed to making Liferay an inclusive, accessible product that leaves nobody out.

#### Our goals are:

- Make accessibility part of the Product Delivery priorities and culture.
- · Generate accessible features by design.
- Give leads, prospects, and customers confidence in Liferay's accessibility capabilities and commitment from the beginning.
- · Get WCAG / ADA certified.

To achieve these goals, we have created the following strategy:

- Clear Ownership and Governance: The Platform Experience and Design System (PEDS) Team is the owner of accessibility and responsible for establishing the guidelines and governance to deliver an accessible product.
- Accessible Design System: We are working to evolve Lexicon, our Design System, to be accessible out-of-the-box.
- Accessible by Design: We are investing accessibility by procuring accessibility training for our designers and developers. In turn we are providing internal guidelines to all Liferay teams to better comply with WCAG/ADA rules, and incorporating accessibility rules into our code review tooling.
- Accessibility Testing by Default: We make sure new features are accessible before they reach the product, by including accessibility tests in our standard QA tests for all delivery teams. These tests are based on the reference tools AXE and JAWS.



• Collaboration: We proactively collaborate with some of the top accessibility companies in the USA and Europe to perform audits on our product and improve continuously.

The entire company is executing this strategy and making Liferay a better product for everybody.

During the past two years, we've improved our design system in these ways:

- Fixed 500 issues affecting over 800 component instances
- Increased compatibility for better screen readers
- Unlocked keyboard use for navigation across the entire portal
- Expanded the compatibility of complex functionalities with assistive technologies
- Addressed highly-complex functionalities like the Page Builder's Drag & Drop

#### **Evaluation Methods Used**

Conformance to the listed accessibility standards has been evaluated by Liferay experts in accessibility using a combination of automated analysis tools and manual testing by keyboard and assistive technologies (screen readers, screen magnifiers, contrast checkers, chromatic vision simulators, etc.). The tests have been applied to a significant and representative number of product pages.
